- ☐ Special items for infants, elderly, or disabled family members



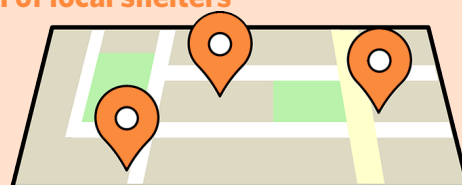
### TOILETRIES

- ☐ Local emergency phone numbers
- ☐ Map of the area
- ☐ Map of emergency evacuation routes
- ☐ Location of local shelters



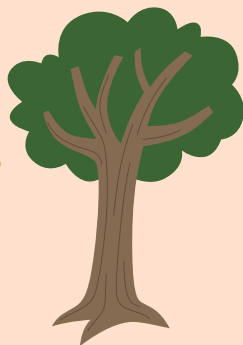
### Pet Travel Tip

## HOME AND CAR PREP

- ☐ Board windows
- ☐ Fill vehicle gas tanks
- ☐ Get a supply of extra gas for generator
- ☐ Move furniture away from windows
- ☐ Remove outdoor items
- ☐ Trim dead tree branches



## IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

- ☐ Birth and marriage certificate
- ☐ Driver's license and Social Security card
- ☐ Home inventory list
- ☐ Insurance policies
- ☐ Medical records
- ☐ Stocks, bonds, and other negotiable contracts
- ☐ Wills, deeds, and copies of recent tax returns



## TOOLS AND SUPPLIES

- ☐ Extra cash
- ☐ Sturdy Shoes
- ☐ Battery-powered radio and NOAA weather radio
- ☐ Cell phone and cell phone charger
- ☐ Clothing and bedding
- ☐ Cooler
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Outdoor grill and supplies

- ☐ Manual can opener
